



## Can you identify this condition?

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21-year-old man from Sudan presented with a large facial mass. During the 3 months after his arrival in Canada, it had gradually grown to a roundish raised lesion 3 cm in diameter (Figure 1). Although there was local pain, there was no discharge, fever, or weight loss. No local lymphadenopathy or hepatosplenomegaly was found. A biopsy of the lesion showed many tiny roundish and basophilic structures within macrophages (Figure 2).

## The most likely diagnosis is

- 1. Blastomycosis
- 2. Cutaneous leishmaniasis
- 3. Tuberculosis
- 4. Squamous cell carcinoma
