



Can you identify this condition?

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A 48-year-old healthy Asian man presents with a 4-year history of a circumscribed pruritic plaque on the dorsal aspect of his right thumb. The plaque is thickened, with exaggeration of the normal skin markings.

The most likely diagnosis is

1. Lichen simplex chronicus
2. Dyshidrotic eczema (pompholyx)
3. Psoriasis
4. Tinea manuum
5. Granuloma annulare

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
