In the letter to the editor entitled "Labour pains," which appeared in the January 2008 issue (*Can Fam Physician* 2008;54:28-9), an error was made in the units provided; 75 mg should have read 75 µg in the following statement: "Having tried many combinations of [intrathecal] drugs, however, my spinal anesthetic of choice for cesarean section is heavy bupivacaine (9 to 10 mg), with morphine (75 µg), and midazolam (2 mg)." *Canadian Family Physician* apologizes for this error and any confusion it might have caused.
