7-year-old boy presented to the clinic with a 6-week history of a Agrowing tumour on his scalp. He was attending school and had no pets at home. Physical examination revealed a 4-cm by 4-cm crusted tumour on the vertex with occipital lymph node enlargement.

The most likely diagnosis is

- 1. Kerion (inflammatory tinea capitis)
- 2. Pyogenic abscess
- 3. Metastatic cancer to scalp
- 4. Deep fungal infection
