Dr. Baraa Alghalyini is presently (since Oct-2012) working as an Assistant Professor & Chair of the Family & Community Medicine Department at College of Medicine, Alfaisal University, Riyadh.

Dr. Baraa Alghalyini works as a consultant family physician at the Department of Emergency Medicine at King Faisal Specialist Hospital & Research Centre (2013-present). Earlier, she has worked as a Consultant at King Abdulaziz Medical City, Riyadh from Sept 2009 to July 2012 and the Consulting Clinics 2012-16.

In 2017 Dr. Alghalyini joined the Saudi Commission for Health Specialities as a Consultant in the Division of Training, and Chair of "Train the Trainer" programs Advisory Committee (2017-2019). In addition, she joined the Ministry of Health Model of Care program, in alignment of the Saudi 2030 Vision, as a leader of the Co-learning workstream (2017-2018).

Dr. Baraa Alghalyini is the founder of the "Health Promotion Exhibition." An annual event at Alfaisal University to promote health and well-being across the community by raising the awareness not only to medical but rather to the holistic wellness components including physical, mental, social and environmental issues.

In 2016 she's become the first University of Toronto Alumni representative in Riyadh. Moreover, she is the first appointed Saudi adjunct faculty at the (DFCM) Department of Family and Community Medicine in Toronto (2006-present). At the DFCM, she continued to participate actively in the academic fellowship and Global Health Programs. In 2019, she accepted the invitation to join as an advisory council member of the Besrou Center for Global Family Medicine at the Canadian College of Family Physicians.

She completed her Residency (from March-2002 to April-2004) in Family Medicine Dept. at St. Michael's Hospital, University of Toronto, Canada. Thereafter, she completed her master's in health sciences (MHSc) from the School of Public Health at the University of Toronto & Family Medicine Fellowship from the same institute (Jun-2004 to Apr-2006).

In Nov-2016 she was awarded (FCFP) Fellowship from The College of Family Physicians of Canada.

Dr. Baraa Alghalyini has contributed immensely in the field of Family Medicine teaching, continuous professional development, and research.
